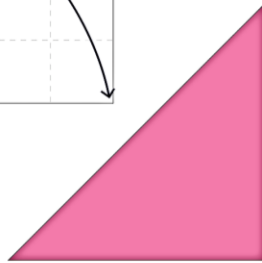
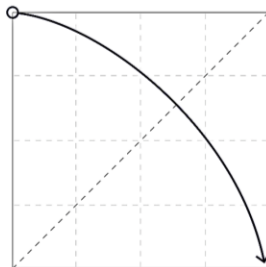
1. Fold the paper in half



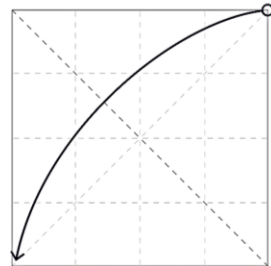
2. Create a tri-fold by folding the edges in to the center crease.



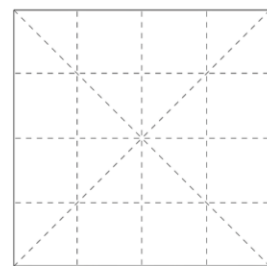
3. Rotate paper and repeat to create folded grid.



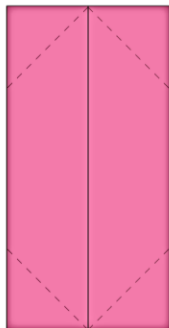
4. Fold the paper diagonally.



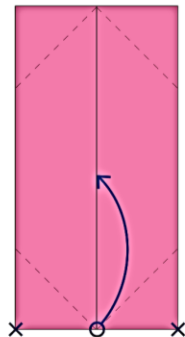
5. Unfold the paper and fold diagonally in other direction.



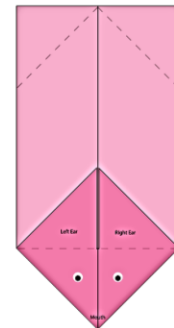
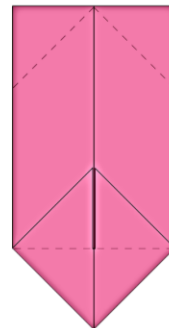
6. Folds should now look like this

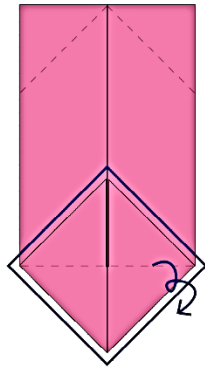


7. Return paper to a tri-fold.



8. Now, you will pull where the corners meet up to the tri-fold seam. Where the "X's are will also land along the seam. Now flatten the ends down into a diamond (this will end up being the rabbit face).

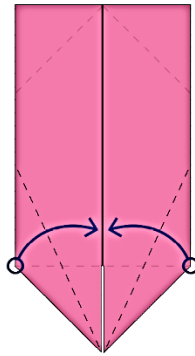




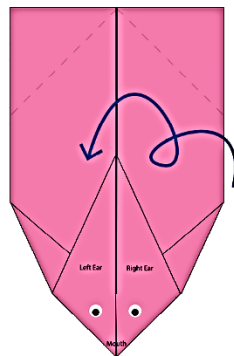
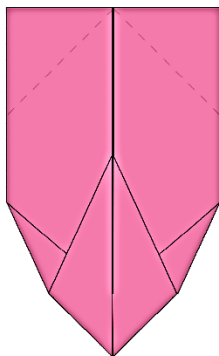
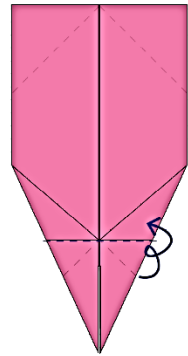
9. Take the diamond shape and pivot it so that the rabbit is "facing down."



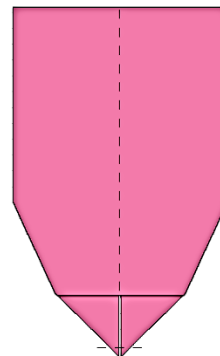
10. Fold along the dotted lines.



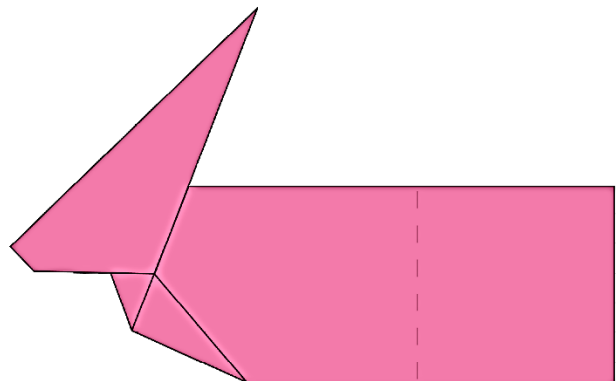
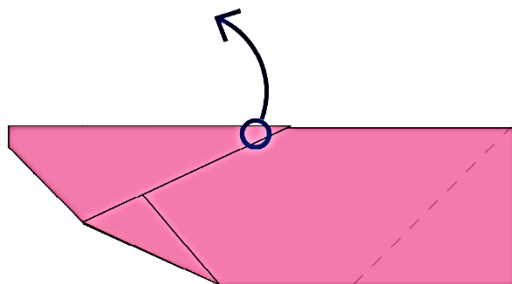
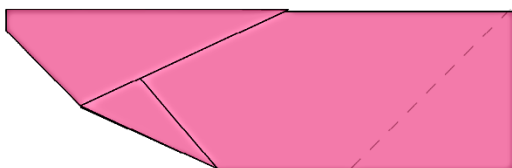
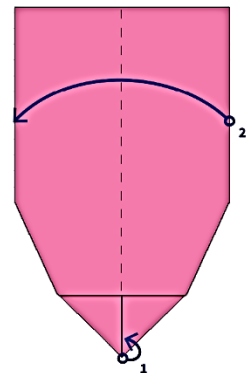
11. Pivot the head to "face up" again.



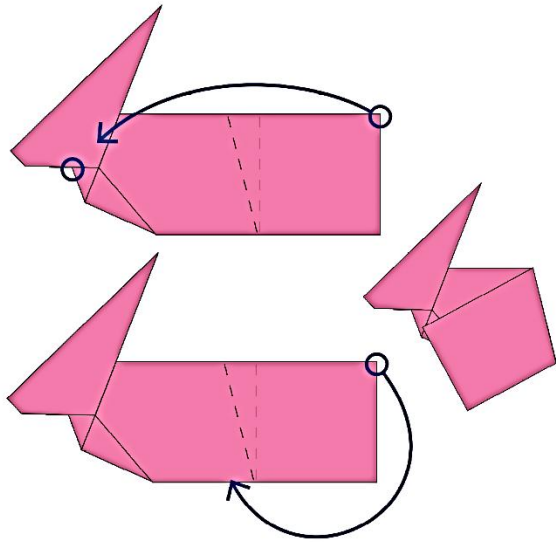
12. Flip the entire piece over.



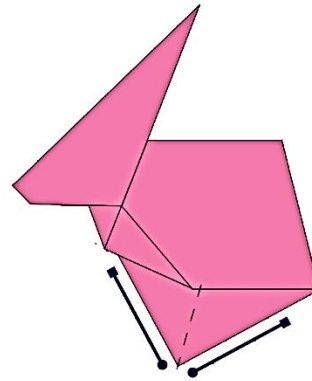
13. Fold a notch at the tip of the face, then fold the piece like a book.



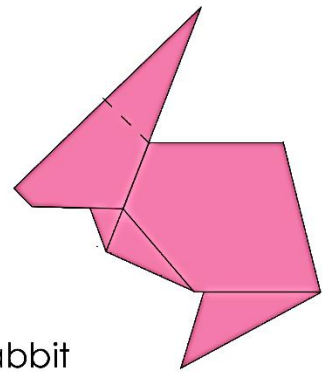
14. Now grab the tips of the ears and gently tug them upward. Once you have them positioned at the angle you like, flatten the piece once more.



15. Fold the paper along the dotted line, unfold, then invert the section so that it folds up into the rabbit body.



16. Fold the section tucked inside the rabbit body so that the blue lines marked above meet and flatten.



17. Fold ears on line and pop them out.
