## ⇒ Adjective

Meaning:

- Expressing feelings or opinions in a very loud or forceful way
- A very loud shouting or calling out
- Vociferous people express their opinions and complaints loudly and repeatedly in speech
- Vociferous demands, etc. are made repeatedly and loudly
  - Think of it having the word 'voice' in it – it's when the 'voice' is used loudly


Examples:

- She gave a **vociferous** cheer when her team scored a goal.
- The **vociferous** dog barked loudly at the mailman.
- The crowd was **vociferous** during the concert.
- My brother was **vociferous** when he didn't get his way.

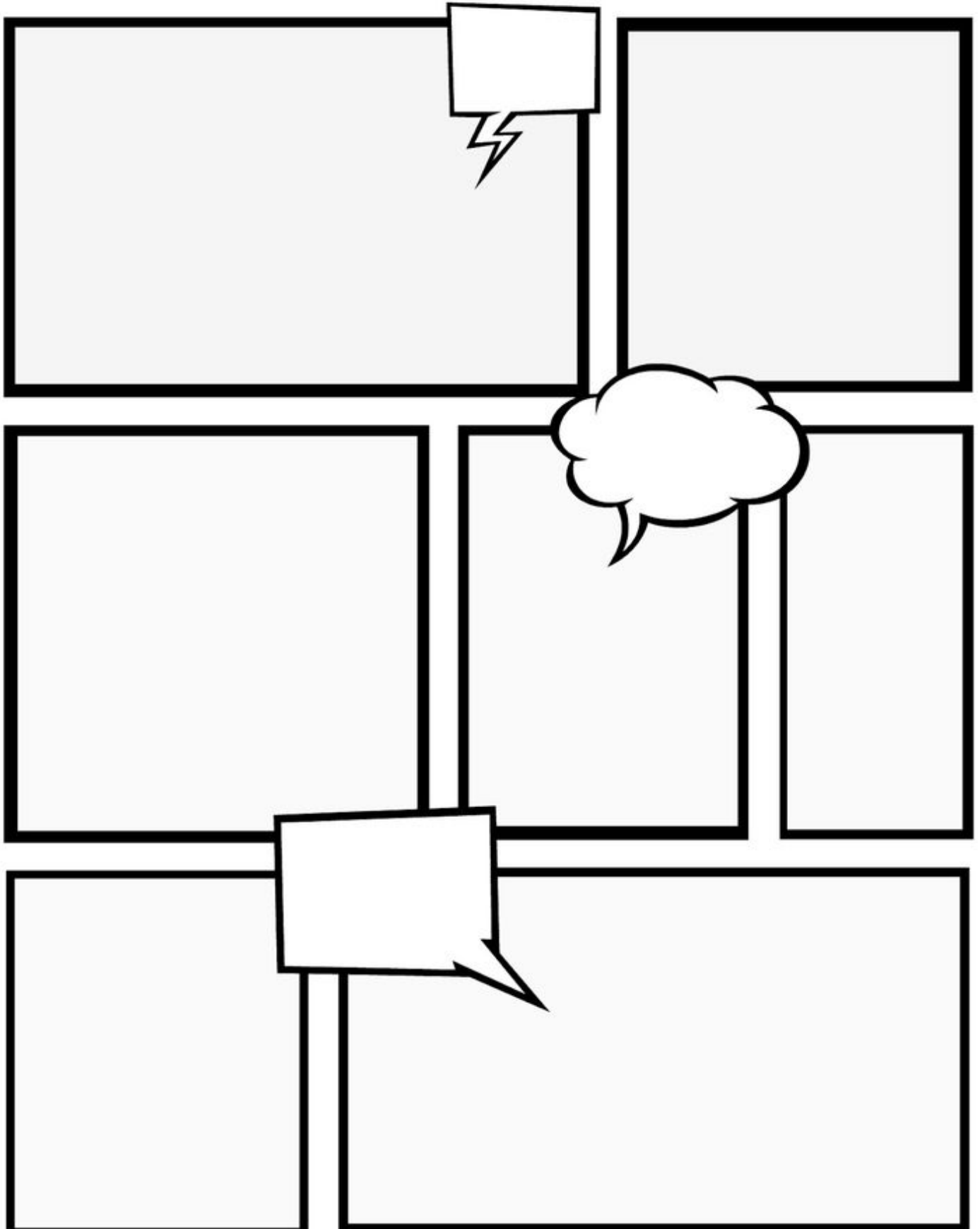
# Skit
